

[Antiviral] Employee Program

An Important Message for all Employee [Antiviral] Distribution Program Participants

The [Antiviral] received by eligible employees in the [Company] Employee [Antiviral] Distribution Program is *for pandemic use only*. This supply of [Antiviral] *should not be used in any other circumstance*, including a suspected case of seasonal flu or other viral illness in the household. Furthermore, it should not be taken in the event of a pandemic or in any other situation, *without consulting first with a physician*.

- **If you or a member of your household has symptoms of flu, contact your physician.** (For a listing of common flu symptoms, go to www.flufacts.com.) Your physician may diagnose flu and, if appropriate, may prescribe [Antiviral]. Be sure to fill any new prescription for [Antiviral] at your pharmacy.
- **If you believe someone in your household has another type of viral infection, contact your physician for appropriate guidance.** NOTE: [Antiviral] is not effective against *all* viruses; it is effective for the treatment and prevention of influenza types A and B in patients aged one year and older. It works by blocking an enzyme (a protein) on the surface of these viruses, which stops them from multiplying. If you or another member of your household has an illness other than flu that is causing their symptoms, contacting a physician will enable prompt diagnosis and appropriate treatment.
- **Reserve your [Antiviral] supply for pandemic use.** Presently, there is no flu pandemic. It is extremely important that you reserve your [Antiviral] supply so that it is available to you in the event of a flu pandemic. [Company] *will not replace this product*.
